



## **AWHA Code of Conduct – For all Competitors**

In addition to the AWWA Ltd General Code of Conduct, the following requirements must be met by competitors during any activity held or sanctioned by the AWWA Ltd, or as a rider/participant in any activity held by or under the auspices of the organisation or one of its affiliates:

- Abide by the principles of the AWWA Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of fellow riders, competitors, officials, volunteers and spectators.
- Do not tolerate acts of aggression.
- Respect the talent, potential and development of fellow riders and competitors.
- Care for and respect the equipment provided to you as part of any AWWA Ltd event.
- Conduct yourself in a professional manner relating to language, temper and punctuality, be courteous, kind and always set a good example in dress and behaviour.
- Maintain high personal behaviour standards at all times.
- AWWA Officials have the discretionary power to disqualify person(s) responsible or, request a spectator's removal from an AWWA event, if they assess that person(s) to be in breach of the AWWA Code of Conduct(s).
- Abide by the rules and respect the decision of the official, making all appeals through the formal process and respecting the final decision.
