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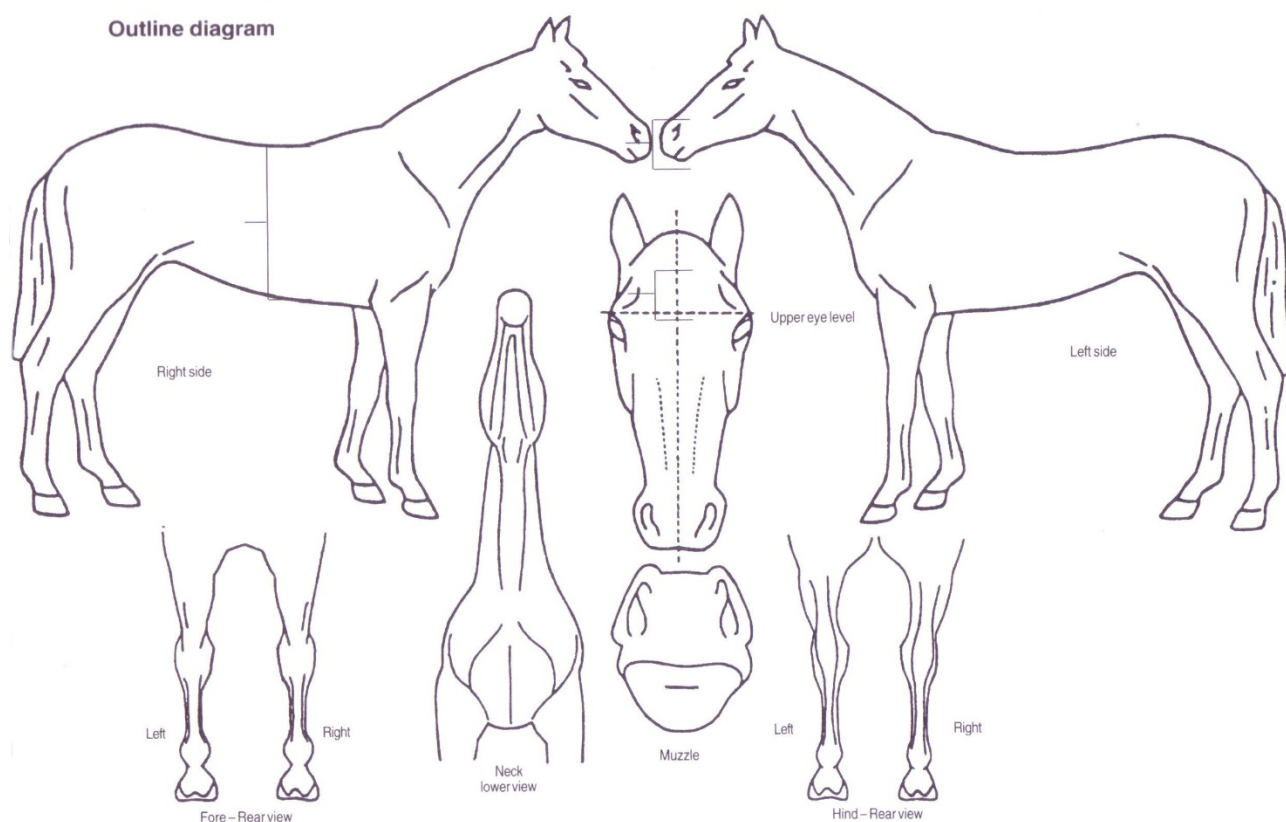

If there are no white markings, this fact must be stated.** All head and neck whorls should be marked (X). Other whorls should be similarly recorded in grey coloured horses and in horses lacking sufficient other distinguishing marks. Acquired marks and other distinguishing marks e.g. prophet's thumb mark, walleye, etc. should always be noted. If a microchip has been implanted please mark the location with an arrow.

Please use the Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) [Identification of Horses with the narrative and the diagram](#) document when describing the horse's markings and scars. This document is designed to simplify the identification of horses and attempt to standardise the many technical details required for the narrative and diagram for the horse's registration certificate.
