FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

How do I know if my horse is a STUD BOOK OR WPRB class?

Look for the 'Status' on the AWhA registration certificate. If the 'Status' reads Warmblood Performance Registration Book (WPRB) or Warmblood Identification Register (WID) your horse will enter the WPRB/WID classes. All other horses will be in the Stud Book classes. If your horse is entered registration pending, please contact the Federal Registrar via email: registrar@awha.com.au to obtain the status of your horse.

How do I know which class my foal is eligible for?

If the Stallion is an Approved/Licensed/IFS **Stallion** with the AWhA and the **Mare** has been Classified by the AWhA, i.e. both parents have been classified, the foal is entered into the STUD BOOK class. All others are entered into the WPRB.

How many horse entries do I need for a Stud Stop?

The AWhA will prioritise each Stud Stop in your state. Entries with high numbers of horses will have priority over 1 entry. Each state will have the availability of access to an OPEN VENUE for everyone to attend to make it easier for the 1 entrant to attend. Stud Stops will try to cater for everyone, but this will be at the discretion of the AWhA Tour Secretary. It is of utmost importance that the AWhA will endeavour to fit everyone in, but we cannot guarantee a stud stop for one horse. If you are unable to travel with your horse, please advise on entry form. Everyone will need to follow COVID-19 requirements.

FREE ENTRIES FOR THE FOLLOWING AWhA HORSES

- All foals that are **first to register** with the AWhA and have an AWhA UELN issued, will have 1 free entry into the AWhA class. Payment will only be needed for the Open Class if you would like to enter that CLASS.
- Special Prize to the "Owner of the Stallion" for the Highest scored progeny of the Stallion from AWhA Approved/Licensed Stallions standing in Australia – Stallion Owner must be a current financial member of the AWhA with the stallion in their name - prize for Led Studbook & WPRB, prize for ridden Studbook & WPRB.
- Special Prize for the Highest Combined Led & Ridden Score Studbook & WPRB.

What requirements are needed on my property to have an open venue or to show my horse off well

- With an Open Venue, you must be able to supply washroom facilities to all who attend. Be able to supply parking for cars and floats. Be able to supply an area to be able to let any horses run free without being able to jump out of the contained area. Have a good surface for any ridden entries 60m x 20m. Be able to meet with the COVID-19 restrictions as supplied by each state government. To be able to supply a safe environment.
- With your own personal stud stop, it is advised you have an area in which you are able to let your horse run free without jumping out. To be able to supply an area 60m x 20m which you can ride on in the ridden section if entered. **You will be bound by the COVID-19 restrictions as applied to by each individual state.**

INTERNATIONAL JUDGE – JOHN THOMPSON (NZL)

Grand Prix Dressage rider John Thompson is one of the New Zealand's young Stars. He is known for his effervescent personality, professional manner and extraordinary capabilities.

John made his international show debut in 2013 aboard the Warmblood gelding, Astute (Anamour x Calypso Girl). The stallion, Anamour, is an Imported Hanoverian stallion that resided in New Zealand.

In 2015 John competed in the CDI Grand Prix aboard Antonello (Anamour x Flair (Winnebago)). John won the Horse of the Year title in Hastings in 2016 and 2018 and became New Zealand Grand Prix Champion in 2018. He was set to compete at the World Equestrian Games in 2018, but unfortunately had to withdraw. Not to be held back, John graciously devoted his time and showcased one of his other talents as a commentator for the event keeping the horse community up to date, enthralling the crowd with his expert commentary.

In Europe, John bought another young Warmblood stallion, JHT Chemistry KWPN (Connaisseur (Hann) x Cendea (Johnson TN) who is now 8 years old, trained by John and already successful at Grand Prix, being short listed for the Tokyo Olympics for the New Zealand team.

John has many highlights including Reserve for the Rio Olympics and breaking into the 100 world rider rankings. John has also been successful at Australia's Dressage & Jumping with the Stars winning the Championships and producing many young successful Warmblood horses.

John has been selected for the ESNZ High Performance Squad for 2020/2021 and the horse community is waiting with anticipation to see if Chemistry and John make it to the Olympics; this time around with this young Warmblood stallion.

John has the ability to buy, produce, sell, and breed quality Warmblood horses. The AWA is looking forward to the expertise and advice that he will bestow on our entrants, from foals right through to ridden Australian Warmblood horses during the AWA Ltd 2021 National Championship and Classification Tour.

A photocopy of paperwork submitted to the other association and receipt of payment to the other association must be supplied to the AWA for the entry to be accepted. AWA registration payment and AWA forms completed and paid for is also required.

Owners must be current financial members of their respective association. **Please attach a copy of your horse/s registration papers and proof of membership to your entry form.** For foals and horses that are registration pending, please attach a copy of your association's registration application form and payment slip.

* **Where applicable:** foals shall be entered registration pending, inclusive of foals that are not yet born, by the closing date of 28th February 2021. **Please note: Entries for Foals and Horses that are Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the Federal AWHA Registrations Administrator.**

All Warmblood horses competing in open classes must be registered with a breed association such as the AWHA Ltd, A.C.E. Group Inc., Hanoverian Horse Society of Australia (HNSA), Holsteiner Horse Association of Australia (HHAA), International Sporthorse Studbook Australia (ISSA) or Trakehners Australia Inc.

Please note: horses competing in Open classes must have a **minimum of 25% Warmblood breeding** in their pedigree. **Proof of registration is required with entry.**

AWHA Ltd members who have a horse/s participating in both the AWHA Ltd classes as well as the Open classes may elect to have their AWHA Ltd class score transferred as their Open class score. Alternatively, AWHA Ltd members may re-present their horse/s for the Open class and receive an additional score sheet and marks

AWHA Ltd 2021 National Championship and Classification Tour – **MARE & COLT CLASSIFICATION**

MARE CLASSIFICATIONS: all Warmblood mares being classified on tour may also enter their relevant **AWHA Ltd led class** - noting that no discount applies to the Mare Classification fee or the National Championship entry fee.

THOROUGHBRED & ANGLO ARABIAN MARES are also invited to be CLASSIFIED ON TOUR.

AWHA LTD 2021 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIP AND CLASSIFICATION TOUR RULES

1. Entries may be accepted as valid if received by the closing date of Sunday **28th February 2021**.
2. Entries for Foals and Horses that are AWhA Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the AWhA Ltd Federal Registrar i.e. all required AWhA registration paperwork and payment must be submitted in advance of acceptance of the Tour entry for classes and respective paperwork.
3. Entries for Foals and Horses in the Open Classes that are Registration Pending will be accepted at the discretion of the AWhA Ltd Federal Registrar.
4. No refunds after close of entries without a veterinary or medical certificate. A \$15 administration fee applies irrespective of the circumstances for cancellation of entry.
5. Entries must include a copy of the horse/s registration papers or registration application form (if applicable). Classes are open to all horses registered with the AWhA Ltd (AWhA Ltd Stud Book, Stud Book Appendix, Warmblood Performance Registration Book (ex Warmblood Identification (WID) Register), Warmblood Foundation Mare Register (WFM)).
6. Handlers and riders who ARE NOT current financial members of the AWhA Ltd shall complete and sign the [AWHA Ltd Non-Member Application / Entry Form Release of Waiver of Liability form](#) and pay \$20 for AWhA Ltd day membership. **The waiver form and associated fee must accompany your entry form. Please include the name of Handlers who are not current financial AWhA Members in your entry.**
7. AWhA Ltd handlers and riders are to complete and sign the [AWHA Ltd Member Dangerous Activity Acknowledgement form](#). **This acknowledgement form must accompany your entry.**
8. [AWHA Ltd Horse Health Declarations](#) must be **completed and signed ON THE DAY of your Class/es**. Please ensure you bring this with you and hand in to the AWhA Ltd tour representative on the day. Please note: **Hendra vaccination is not compulsory.**
9. Entire male horses 3 years of age and over must adhere to Equestrian Australia's [EA Stallion safe practices guidelines](#). No colt or stallion may be presented by anyone under 18 years of age. All entire males 2 years of age and over must be led with a bridle and bit.
10. ASA approved safety helmets must be worn at all times when riding, including during warm-up.
11. All exhibits in ridden classes must be ridden in a snaffle bridle. Use of side saddles and martingales is prohibited. Spurs must comply with EA guidelines.
12. All handlers and riders of exhibits (excluding colts and stallions) must be a minimum of fourteen years of age.
13. COVID-19 safety rules will apply per each state legislation on Tour.
