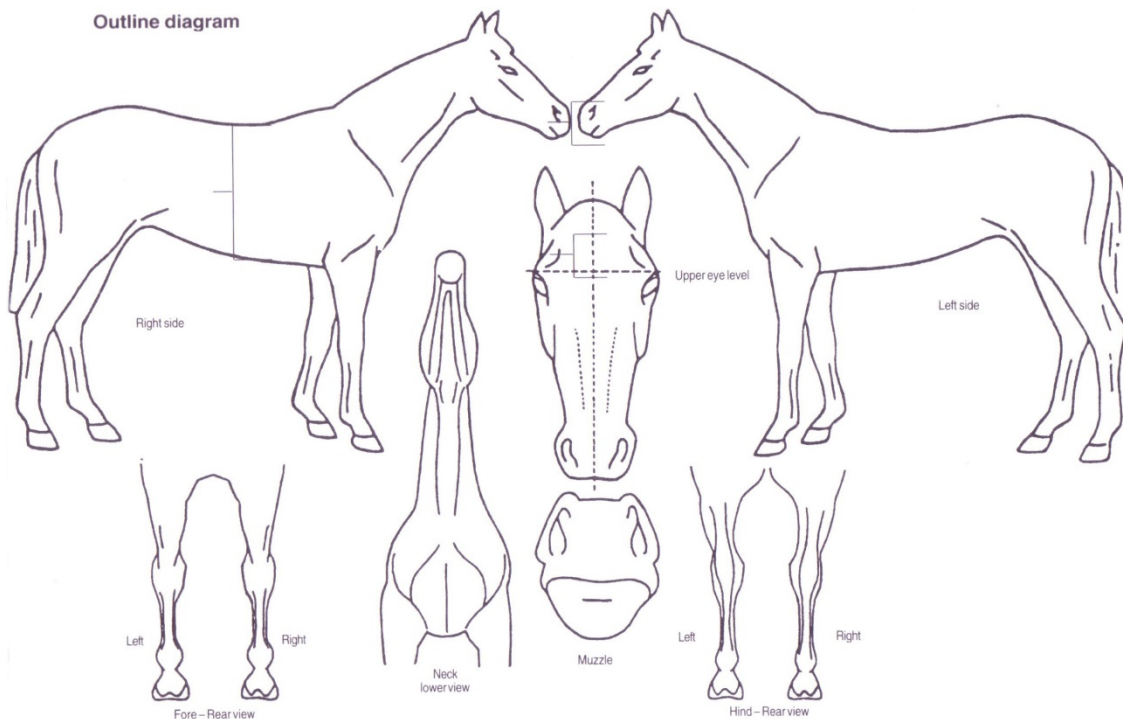

Other whorls should be similarly recorded in grey coloured horses and in horses lacking sufficient other distinguishing marks. Acquired marks and other distinguishing marks e.g. prophet's thumb mark, walleye, etc. should always be noted. If a microchip has been implanted please mark the location with an arrow.
